#### **NOTES ON AWARDS**

##### **Awards for Personal Achievement**

These awards are made to pupils in S1-4 who have gained, over the course of the year, 'Excellent' grades for effort in their subjects as follows: 11+ 'Excellents' in S1; 12+ 'Excellents' in S2; 7+ 'Excellents' in S3/4.

##### **Personal Achievement Colours**

Awarded to all students who achieved 'Excellent' for effort across subjects throughout S5.

##### **Awards for Subject Attainment**

These subject awards are presented to the highest achieving students in SQA examinations. Most of our S5 as well as some of our S4 awards are sponsored by local companies and individuals. We gratefully acknowledge the continued support of our awards' sponsors.

##### **Academic Colours**

Awarded to all pupils who achieved 5 'A' passes in SQA Higher Grade Examinations in S5.

##### **Sporting Awards – Scottish Champions and Internationalists**

These awards are presented in recognition of excellence in sport. Recipients were selected to represent their country at international level during the session or won Scottish championships in their sport.

##### **Sports Champions**

These awards are based on performances on the School's Sports Day.

##### **The Philippa Bogle Memorial Prize for Problem Solving**

This trophy is awarded annually to the best problem solver in S1 Mathematics in memory of Philippa Bogle who was for a great many years the Assistant Principal Teacher of Mathematics at this school.

##### **The Guildry of Stirling Prize**

This prize is donated annually by the Guildry of Stirling to the highest achieving student in Advanced Higher History.

##### **UK Maths Olympiad**

This is a UK wide age-related Maths competition. Over 1200 pupils from across the UK participated. To achieve a Silver Medal along with a distinction, pupils have to have been placed in the top 90 participants.

##### **Arkwright Scholarship**

The Arkwright Scholarships Trust is a UK not-for-profit organisation which seeks to create future leaders in engineering and design by increasing the number of outstanding young people who pursue university courses and careers in these subjects. The trust awards prestigious Arkwright Scholarships to high-quality students across the UK to support them through their 'A' levels and Scottish Highers.

##### **Proxime Accessit**

Awarded to the highest attaining student, other than the Dux, in SQA examinations over S5 and S6.

##### **DUX MEDAL**

A new DUX MEDAL sponsored by the newly re-constituted Parent Council has been struck and will be awarded from this year onwards to the highest attaining student in SQA exams over S5 and S6.
